RE:	Raptor Technologies, Inc. Direct Negotiated Contract

On February 7, 2006, official action (attached) was given to allow permission to negotiate a direct contract with Raptor Technologies, Inc. for the purchase of control campus security systems "as needed" for use throughout the District using the Department of Education Rule 6A-1.012(10), a district school board, when acquiring technology resources may make any acquisition through direct negotiation and contract with a vendor as best fits the needs of the school district.

As indicated in our previous request, the attached contract with pricing is being submitted for your approval. This is a three-year contract, renewable annually based upon mutual consent of both parties. The first year of the contract shall be effective from March 8, 2006 to March 7, 2007. The anticipated initial expenditures will be approximately \$62,000 to install the Raptor System in all of our elementary schools. Grand total of annual expenditures may vary with more or less use of the "unit prices". Unit prices are a firm fixed price for the entire contract period.
