History

The Tech Prep Articulation Agreement between Johnson and Wales University and the District School Board of Pasco County is updated to reflect current course and program titles for both the university and the school district.

Description

The Tech Prep Articulation Agreement must be Board approved to enable high school students who complete the Commercial Foods and Culinary Arts Program to receive college credit in specific post-secondary programs once they enroll at Johnson & Wales University. The agreement saves students and parents time and money as it gives students college credit for content they complete in secondary course work.

The staff requests Board approval of the enclosed updated agreement with extension of the expiration date to 2011.

TECH PREP ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN JOHNSON & WALES UNIVERSITY AND THE DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD OF PASCO COUNTY

In a continuing effort for the Pasco-Hernando Tech Prep Consortium to provide career opportunities for secondary school students in Tech Prep programs to progress through an associate degree program in minimal time with minimal duplication of course work, Johnson & Wales University and the District School Board of Pasco County agree to extend at no cost to the student college credit for completion of the Commercial Foods Program at Marchman Technical Education Center according to the following requirements.

To articulate completion of the Commercial Foods Program at Marchman Technical Education Center to Johnson & Wales University, students must meet the following requirements to earn college credit.

- 1. The student must be considered a Tech Prep student defined as:

 A student enrolled in an articulated sequential program of study at grade level or above (Level 2 and 3 courses--Algebra I, equivalent, and higher) by the eleventh grade in mathematics, science, and communications, including a technical component (vocational class), which leads to a MINIMUM of a 2-year post secondary degree or certificate and/or apprenticeship program.
- 2. The student must have earned an overall unweighted 2.0 GPA in high school and a GPA of 3.0 in the Commercial Foods Program.
- 3. The student must have competed the two years of the Commercial Foods Program (8763000).
- 4. The student must have a letter of recommendation from the Commercial Foods instructor.
- 5. Students are expected to complete the required admissions application form.
- 6. The student must submit an official high school transcript.



Students will earn transfer credits for the following Culinary Arts Laboratory Segments for 9-quarter credit hours total:

•	CUL1345	Introduction to Baking & Pastry Arts	3 quarter credit hours
•	CUL1355	New World Cuisine	3 quarter credit hours
•	CUL1385	Fundamentals of Food Service Production	3 quarter credit hours

Students who submit a certificate from the National Restaurant Association, The National Registry of Food Safety Professionals or Thomsen Prometric with their admissions application will be exempt from Johnson & Wales' FSM1065 (Sanitation Management).

After receiving transfer credit for work they've already done in high school, FAST students must complete the remaining coursework at Johnson & Wales:

- Two terms of academics
- Remaining terms of culinary arts laboratory segments
- One term of Culinary Arts applications (internship)

Students who elect to enter the Hotel Management, Restaurant Management or Food & Beverage Management associate degree programs may also earn the transfer credits listed below:

Hotel & Lodging Management B.S.

FSM2085 Hotel Food and Beverage Operations – 4.5 quarter credits

International Hotel & Tourism Management B.S.*

FSM2085 Hotel Food and Beverage Operations — 4.5 quarter credits
*Applications for the International Hotel & Tourism Management program are accepted during a student's freshman year through the International Hotel School. Please refer to the JWU catalog for further information.

Restaurant, Food & Beverage Management B.S.

CUL1355	New World Cuisine – 3 quarter credits
CUL 1385	Fundamentals of Food Service Production – 3 quarter credits

Terms of Agreement:

This agreement shall be reviewed **annually** and shall be effective immediately upon signing by both parties and until either party, with thirty days written notice, identifies a need for revision or, with ninety days written notice, intent to terminate the agreement at the end of the school, college term.

Johnson & Wales University shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinaces, codes, & statutes of any & all local, state, or national governing bodies included within this section.
