Recommendation: Recommend acceptance of Request for Proposal per the attached tabulation. Per the terms of the RFP, acceptance of the three (3) highest-ranked firms will enable the New Construction and Code Compliance Department to utilize the services of all three firms on a rotational basis, with the initial rotation schedule established by the final rank order. When projects within the scope of this RFP are generated, the New Construction and Code Compliance Department will conduct pricing negotiations on the project with the next firm in rotation, in good faith and in accordance with Section 287.055, F.S. Should the District fail to reach accord as to pricing with supplier in rotation, the District reserves the right to negotiate, in turn, with the next ranked supplier until agreement is reached.

On projects within the scope of this RFP, should the District be unable to successfully negotiate a contract with the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd ranked suppliers, we are asking for permission to negotiate for that package with suppliers ranked 4th and lower, in descending order until a successful negotiation has been reached.

Term of Contract: This is a three-year contract, renewable annually based upon the mutual consent of both parties. Services for Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing Engineering will be used on an "as-needed" basis by the New Construction and Code Compliance Department. The first year term of this contract will be June 19, 2007 to June 18, 2008.

Notations and Exceptions: Readers scored the fourteen (14) proposals, and all scores were totaled and averaged to obtain a ranking, highest to lowest. Recommend acceptance of Carastro & Associates, Inc. as the first-ranked firm, Hahn Engineering, Inc. as the second-ranked firm, and GLE Associates, Inc. as the third-ranked firm.
