It is the intent of this agreement that American Health Institute will provide the opportunities for High Schools graduates to receive credit for appropriate course work completed at Pasco High Schools ("Schools") AHI agrees to award credit to Pasco Community High school graduates as specifically defined below.

#### Medical Coding and Billing

Students may also earn credits for other courses that may be Advanced Placement, not mentioned in this agreement, students would bring in their transcripts to obtain credit for courses after graduation,

Graduates may also earn credits for professional medical certifications received prior to acceptance to AHI. Those certifications may include but are not limited to:

CPR, HIV, First Aid, Blood Borne Pathogens/OSHA, Alzeheimers, Domestic Violence, Assistance with Medication.

#### **General Provisions**

Chair, School Board

- 1. Students will not be charged any fees for the awarding of hours covered by this agreement.
- 2. "Transfer credit" will be given for the credit hours awarded under this agreement.
- 3. Students must receive a "B" or above in the high school courses to be considered in order for credit to be issued.
- 4. In order for the articulated credit(s) to be accepted as an accelerated mechanism, a student must be enrolled at AHI within five (5) years after high school graduation.
- 5. Students may take an 18 hour review course to pass their CNA exam at no extra charge.
- 6. The student is responsible for requesting AHI to initiate the procedure of credit earned through this Agreement.
