- Professional development opportunities for Career Central staff related to educational and career assessment and advisement.
- Promote Career Central services, including services of all affiliated agencies, to adult education students.

This Collaborative Partnership Agreement is made between the District School Board of Pasco County, Community, Career and Technical Education Department and The Pasco County Library System.

This Memorandum covers the period beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 20, 2011.

The Pasco County Library System agrees to provide the following to supplement the District School Board of Pasco County's adult education programs within the Pasco service area:

- Office space, utilities, and existing telecommunication support services within selected library locations for the provision of free District School Board of Pasco County adult education classes made possible through funding from the 2010-11 Adult General Education grant and English Literacy/Civics grants.
- Promote District School Board of Pasco County adult education classes to library patrons through the display of brochures, flyers and special publications.

The District School Board of Pasco County agrees to provide the following services:

- Part-time adult education classes taught by certified District School Board of Pasco County staff, according to a weekly schedule agreed upon by both parties.
- All instructional materials and supplies, textbooks, software, computers and printers, unless prior approval is given to utilize available library computers.
- Professional development opportunities for library staff related to educational and career assessment and advisement.
- Promote library services to adult education students.

### Collaborative Partnership Agreement Between

## District School Board of Pasco County Community, Career and Technical Education Department

### Pasco-Hernando Community College

This Collaborative Partnership Agreement is made by and between the District School Board of Pasco County hereafter referred to as DSBPC and the Community, Career and Technical Education Department, hereafter referred to as CCTE and District Board of Trustees of Pasco-Hernando Community College, hereafter referred to as PHCC.

This agreement covers the period beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011. This agreement will be extended through June 30, 2012, upon mutual agreement of both parties and pending approval of a continuation of the Adult General Education Grant project.

WHEREAS the DSBPC, CCTE AND PHCC wish to collaborate in the administration of the 2010-11 Adult General Education Grant project. The partnership herein will provide for the enhancement of the existing adult education programs in Pasco County by maximizing the use of resources and by collaborating on services offered in the educational service area. The funds will be used to provide the following benefits to adult learners served by adult education initiatives in Pasco County:

- Assist adults in becoming literate and obtaining the knowledge and skills necessary for employment and self-sufficiency;
- Assist adults who are parents in obtaining the educational skills necessary to become full partners in the educational development of their children;
- Assist adults in completing high school or the GED equivalent.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreement in the provisions, terms, and conditions herein set forth, the DSBPC, CCTE, and PHCC mutually agree to the following:

### 1. PHCC Agrees:

- a) To collaborate solely with the DSBPC, CCTE in the administration of the 2010-11 Adult General Education grant.
- b) To provide adult education college transition instructional services to targeted GED students, complementing state-approved performance standards and goals measured by the National Reporting System (NRS). **Deliverable**: Quarterly course enrollment data, including student name, identification information, attendance, course grade/completion of competencies, Pre/Post College Placement Test scores.
- c) To provide a part-time transition specialist (not to exceed 4 hours per week per campus) for the West Campus (New Port Richey) and the East Campus (Dade City) funded through the 2010-11 Adult General Education Grant for advisement, mentoring, and on-site transition services to GED cohort groups, including placement and follow-up data on course completers needed for NRS reporting. PHCC's Assistant Dean of Developmental Education will be responsible for developing and seeking approval for the job description and for supervising and evaluating this employee. Deliverable: Database of enrollment/withdrawal data, including initial PHCC enrollment date, intended major course of study, course/credit history, degree/certificate award, graduation date, commencing with each course completer's enrollment at PHCC and CONTRACT REVIEWED

AND APPROVIDE

continuing throughout the project period for each year that such collaborative agreement is in place.

d) To participate with the DSBPC, CCTE grant instructional staff in transition program meetings and revision recommendations.

### 2. DSBPC, CCTE Agrees:

- a) To serve as fiscal agent for the funds received from the Adult General Education Grant, and as such, will be the administrative entity in the management of the grant funds.
- b) To, upon receipt of quarterly invoicing from PHCC, provide payment from the Adult General Education grant funds for successful completion and documentation of the mutually agreed upon deliverables as defined in 1 (b), 1 (c), and 1 (d) of this agreement. Should PHCC not fulfill the quarterly instructional services and corresponding documentation as defined, the DSBPC, CCTE will submit the required Florida Department of Education project amendment for redistribution of remaining funds.
- c) To establish and coordinate periodic meetings between the partners throughout the project period.
- d) To provide the Florida Department of Education with all necessary documentation, reports, etc., as required for grant funds.
- e) Treat as confidential any student information received pursuant to this agreement that is not defined as directory information by PHCC policies. Such information shall be maintained in a secure manner to avoid disclosure to any unauthorized third party. DSBPC and CCTE shall immediately notify PHCC, in writing, of any unauthorized disclosure; such notice shall include a description of the information disclosed and a description of how the disclosure occurred.

### 3. DSBPC, CCTE and PHCC mutually agree that:

- a) Funds made available through the Adult General Education grant will be used by partners in accordance with existing Florida Department of Education grant guidelines and the approved grant project.
- b) This Collaborative Partnership Agreement may be terminated by either party at any time upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.
- c) This Collaborative Partnership Agreement will be renewed for the 2011-12 grant project year contingent upon fulfillment of terms set forth in this agreement and the allocation of continuation funding by the funding agent.

- Adult education staff will participate in scheduled meetings and events at The Pregnancy Care Center of Zephyrhills on a needs basis.
