RFP 08-014-AZ, Dental Services, MetLife (formerly SafeGuard Dental & Vision)

On November 18, 2008, official action (attached) was taken to award the above-referenced RFP for dental services to MetLife (formerly SafeGuard Dental & Vision.) This RFP is a five-year contract, renewable annually at the mutual agreement of the parties. The second term will expire on December 31, 2009.

Considering services have been satisfactory, the vendor was contacted to verify their willingness to enter into the third year of the agreement under existing terms and conditions. MetLife has agreed in writing (attached) to do so. Rates under this contract are guaranteed for the first three (3) years of the contract. The cost to the Board for the term January 1, 2010 – December 31, 2010 is estimated to be \$1,522,908, paid out of insurance funding. Please reference the attached memo from Ms. Mary Tillman, Director of Employee Benefits, Assistance and Risk Management, for further information.

Recommendation: Recommend acceptance of RFP for Dental Services from SafeGuard Dental & Vision per the attached RFP written documentation (Phase I) tabulation and interview scores (Phase II) tabulation as having the highest average score and best RFP meeting written specifications.

<u>Term of Contract</u>: This is a three (3)-year contract, renewable annually at the mutual agreement of the parties. The first-year term will be January 1, 2008 – December 31, 2008.

Notations and Exceptions: Proposals from Cigna Healthcare, Dental Decisions, and United Concordia were disqualified at the RFP opening for failure to provide mandatory signed bid sheets. Proposal from Humana Dental Insurance was disqualified at the RFP opening for failure to provide mandatory signed Addenda #1 and #2.

The RFP solicited three (3) separate options: Option 1, DHMO/PPO equivalent to or better than plans currently utilized by the District; Option 2, PPO plan only; Option 3, proposer choice of new plan(s) to be offered. All options in Phase I were independently evaluated by the Dental Sub-Committee members, with scores totaled and averaged by option. At a meeting of the full Insurance Committee on June 28, 2007, it was determined that interviews for Phase II should be held regarding Options 1 and 3. Option 2 was eliminated with cost being higher than Board-budgeted amounts.

Notations & Exceptions, continued: Interviews were held by the Sub-Committee on July 11, 2007 with the four (4) highest-ranked proposers for Options 1 and 3. The Committee verified that the District had received all companies' best and final offers regarding pricing and terms before interview results were scored. Phase II interview scores were totaled and averaged by option, and per the RFP specifications were added to the Phase I scores for a final total score. SafeGuard Dental & Vision was the highest-ranked company for both Options 1 and 3. After discussion, the Committee voted to recommend Option 1, DHMO/PPO, to the full Insurance Committee. The Insurance Committee endorsed this recommendation at its meeting on July 12, 2007.

The plans offered by SafeGuard have been confirmed as offering the same or better benefits to District employees. The cost to employees will be lower for the majority of the most heavilyutilized dental services. Reference attached documentation from Ms. Mary Tillman, Director of Employee Benefits and Risk Management (EBARM) for information regarding plan benefits and anticipated costs. The final cost to the Board is forecast to be lower than currently expended, but cannot be definitively stated until a contract with United School Employees of Pasco is finalized.

We are asking for Board approval of this choice of vendor, which will permit EBARM to begin the transition from the current District provider, CompBenefits, and prepare for open enrollment in the fall.

Offers from the vendors listed herein are the only offers received on a timely basis as of the specified date and time. All other offers submitted in response to this solicitation, if any, are hereby rejected as late.
