AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES AND MUTUAL COOPERATION

This agreement made and entered into this 6th day of July, 2010 by and between **CATHOLIC CHARITIES, DIOCESE OF ST. PETERSBURG**, a Florida corporation not for pecuniary profit, herein referred to as "**CATHOLIC CHARITIES**" and the **DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD OF PASCO COUNTY**, hereinafter referred to as the "**SCHOOL BOARD**".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, CATHOLIC CHARITIES has the staff and facilities necessary for providing certain counseling and psycho-educational services in Pasco County, and

WHEREAS, the school system for which the SCHOOL BOARD is responsible requires such services from time to time, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for cooperation and sharing of services and resources between CATHOLIC CHARITIES and the SCHOOL BOARD.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants contained in this agreement, it is agreed by and between the parties that:

- 1 . This agreement shall take effect and be in force from July 06, 2010 until June 30, 2011.
- 2. During the term of the agreement, the supervisory/administrative staff of the two agencies will communicate and cooperate on matters of mutual concern.
- 3. During the term of this agreement **CATHOLIC CHARITIES** shall provide counseling services to students and their families as requested by the **SCHOOL BOARD**.
- 4. The SCHOOL BOARD shall provide appropriate referral information on all cases referred to CATHOLIC CHARITIES.
- 5. a. Each family referred to **CATHOLIC CHARITIES** by the Department of Student Services staff of the **SCHOOL BOARD** shall be eligible for four (4) counseling sessions to be paid for by the **SCHOOL BOARD** at the rate of forty five dollars (\$45.00) per session. Any additional counseling sessions after the first four (4) sessions will be charged to the family unless additional sessions have been approved in advance by the Supervisor of Student Services. Any additional sessions approved for payment will be paid at the rate of forty five dollars (\$45.00) per session by the **SCHOOL BOARD**.
 - b. Students referred for group services by the Department of Student Services staff shall be eligible for six (6) sessions to be paid for by the **SCHOOL BOARD** at the rate of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per session, per student. Any additional group counseling sessions provided to the student will be charged to the family.

AND APPROVED:

6. Total compensation for this contract for counseling services is estimated to be five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00). The final cost will depend on referrals and utilization of services.

- 8. Requests by the SCHOOL BOARD for services to be performed by CATHOLIC CHARITIES shall be authorized by the Director of Student Services through the Supervisor of Student Services.
- 8. Per Florida Statute 1012.32, the agency acknowledges that a Level 2 fingerprint screening is required of any individual who has direct contact with students while delivering services under the provision of this agreement. The agency will provide the names of specific employees who will provide services through direct contact with students and will cooperate with the School Board in meeting the requirements of the referenced statute.
- 10. **CATHOLIC CHARITIES** agrees to accept the designated payment amount as payment in full and shall not seek compensation from additional sources, i.e. insurance, Medicaid, etc.

HOLD HARMLESS:

Each of the parties to this Agreement hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the other party hereto harmless from and against all damages of any nature whatsoever which are caused or materially contributed to by the negligent acts of any officer, employee, and agent or other representative of the indemnifying party and which are not caused or materially contributed to by any officer, employee, agent or other representative of the indemnified party.

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice.
