Action Requested

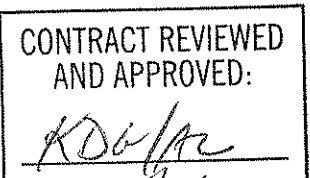

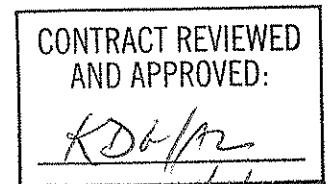

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN

This document defines the conditions of the Culinary Arts Tech Prep Articulation Agreement between Wiregrass Ranch High School and Johnson & Wales University. Students who qualify under the conditions of this agreement receive transfer credits towards a Culinary Arts Associate's Degree.

Stipulations of the Agreement:

- Students are expected to complete the required admissions application form and must submit an official high school transcript. Upon acceptance to Johnson & Wales University, a student will be eligible for consideration of the articulation agreement.
- Students must forward a letter of recommendation from their Culinary Arts instructor.
- Students must have completed the two-year Culinary Arts program to earn credit at Johnson & Wales University towards a Culinary Arts Associate's Degree.
- Students must earn an overall "C" average in high school and a "B" average in their Commercial Foods program.
