Memo of Understanding

The attached agreement between the District Board of Trustees for Pasco Hernando Community College and the District's Exceptional Student Education Department is being forwarded to the Board for approval. A Pasco County ESE student with complex needs is enrolling for the Fall 2010 semester at Pasco Hernando Community College in a PE course. The District is obligated to provide educational services for special needs students. The attached memorandum of understanding allows the District to provide one (1) school board employee to assist/accompany the student. The parent has chosen to enroll her child in this course instead of the option offered through the District/School. There will be no charge to the District for these services. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by Nancy Alfonso, School Board Attorney.

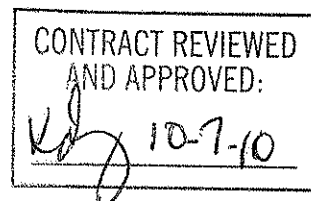
Memorandum of Understanding
Between
***The District Board of Trustees of Pasco-Hernando
Community College***
And
The School Board of Pasco County

Whereas the School Board is obligated to provide educational services for a special needs student and

Whereas said student has expressed a desire to take a course at Pasco-Hernando Community College (the College) during the Fall 2010 semester and

Whereas the parties have agreed to cooperate on a one time basis to determine the feasibility of future arrangements, it is agreed as follows:

1. The Student shall remain an enrollee with the Pasco School Board and may attend a pre-arranged class at the College.
2. The School Board shall remain primarily responsible for the educational plans of the Student and the College is merely a provider of services, for purposes of this agreement.
3. The School Board shall provide appropriate services to the student, including accompaniment by one (1) appropriately qualified School Board employee at all times when the student is on the College campus attending the pre-arranged class.
4. The Student and the School Board employees shall be governed by all rules, policies and procedures, including the code of student conduct, while on College property.
5. The School Board shall be responsible for all salaries and benefits payable to the School Board employees and shall ensure that they are covered by School Board insurance, including workers compensation and appropriate liability insurance.
6. At no time shall the School Board employees hold themselves out as employees or students at the College.
7. That in the event the College is unable to fully accommodate the needs of the student or should the student choose to stop attending, then this agreement shall be cancelled.
8. In the event of a failure to perform by either party under this agreement, the aggrieved party may, in its sole discretion, provide notice to the other party of the deficiency in performance or terminate the agreement by providing not less than ten (10) days written notice to the other party. In the event the aggrieved party elects to notify the other party of the performance deficiency, the other party shall have five (5) days from the date of the notice to correct the deficiency.
9. The parties shall meet prior to the end of the Fall 2010 College Semester to review the success of this agreement, and may at that time extend the agreement, cancel the agreement or develop an ongoing agreement to govern future needs.



IN WITNESS THEREOF, the parties have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed in their respective corporate names and their corporate seals to be affixed by duly authorized officers, all on the day and first set forth above.




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
